Part 1

Park Regulations

§101. Designation of Parks.

The following properties owned by the City of St. Marys are hereby declared to be public parks, subject to the provisions of this Part.

- A. Memorial Park, abutting the eastern side of Wolfel Avenue.
- B. Luhr Park, between Chestnut Street and Walnut Street and abutting Park Street.
- C. Diamond Street Park, abutting the northern side of Grant Street.
- D. Kalmount Park, abutting Hall Avenue.
- E. Benzinger Park, between Fleming Road and Vine Road.
- F. Hickory Road Park, at the corner of Hickory Road and Averyville Road.
- G. The Diamond, being all of the land within the triangle formed by North Michael Street, North St. Marys Street and Railroad Street.

§102. General Regulations.

The following rules and regulations shall apply to all public parks within the City:

- A. No person shall remain in or upon any public park between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., prevailing time of the following day, except where a special permit has been issued by the City Manager.
- B. The City Manager may issue a special permit to conduct a public activity by a civic or charitable organization, subject to such limitations of time and conduct as the City Manager may deem appropriate to protect persons and property in and around the public park.
- C. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on the walks, paths, roads or other improved surfaces of a public park.
- D. No person shall ride, lead or drive a horse or other animal in any public park.
- E. No person shall permit any dog or other animal to defecate in any public park.

F. No person shall use or possess any alcoholic beverages in any public park.

§103. Additional Regulations.

The St. Marys Recreation Board, with the approval of City Council, may from time to time establish such additional rules and regulations for the use of any public park as it shall deem necessary for the proper use and protection of the public park. (Ord. 38, 1/15/1996, §103)

§104. Penalties.

1. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Part shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and costs of suit.
2. Any person violating any of the rules and regulations adopted by the St. Marys Recreation Board for any public park pursuant to this Part shall be subject to the penalties prescribed in such rules and regulations.
