May 25, 2005

CALL TO ORDER

A special Council meeting of the City of Saint Marys was called to order by Mayor David Meier on Wednesday, May 25, 2005 at 12:15 p.m. The meeting was held in the Council Room of City Hall, 808 South Michael Street. Rescind motion

Gelindo Bonfardine made a motion to rescind his motion he made at the last meeting in which he listed the roads that were going to be paved. Thomas Farley seconded the rescinded motion, and all were in favor. (For the record, this includes both the 1st motion and the amended motion made during the May 16th meeting)

Award of Paving

Gelindo Bonfardine made a motion to award the 2005 paving bid to HRI, Inc. with the stipulation that the City Manager make the decision as to what roads to pave. The motion was seconded by Thomas Farley, and all were in favor.

Paving Petition for Thunder, Sumar, and Baumer Roads

Manager Greene stated residents of Thunder, Sumar, and Baumer Roads presented a petition to the City to have their roads paved by assessment. For a road to be considered for paving by assessment, more than 51% of the property owners must agree. Thunder Road had 70% and Sumar Road had approximately 60%. Baumer Road did not receive more than 51% of the residents' signatures.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion made by Thomas Farley, seconded by Gelindo Bonfardine, and all were in favor.
