Carol Muhitch re: 2006 Budget

Carol Muhitch, Finance Director, explained the City's 2006 budget. Two changes have been made. A 5% increase in real estate taxes will be added to the General Fund. Also, the Sewage Treatment Plant projects, for which the Municipal Authority will not reimburse the City, have been removed from the budget.

Ordinance No. 215 was presented providing for the Levy and Assessment of Taxes for the City of St. Marys for the Fiscal Year 2006.
